STUDENT DRESS CODE

The intent of school dress code at RBA is to promote a positive academic atmosphere and to place emphasis on the attitude and character development rather than on external appearance. In addition, school dress code enables teachers, administrators, and parents to easily identify RBA students.

Girls

Shirts: Solid shirts in navy, white, or gray. An RBA approved t-shirt or sweatshirt may be worn. No writing, characters or large brand logos on any shirts.

Pants: Solid Colored Pants or Shorts in navy, blue-wash denim or khaki (length within 2" of the top of the knee) No rips or holes.

<u>Jumper/Dress/Skirt:</u> Solid jumper, dress or skirt in the colors navy and khaki may be worn with a solid white collared shirt. (shorts or leggings should be worn under the jumper or skirt)

Boys

Shirts: SolidShirts in navy, white, or gray. An RBA approved t-shirt or sweatshirt may be worn. No writing, characters or large brand logos.

<u>Pants:</u> Solid Colored Pants or Shorts in navy, blue-wash denim or khaki (length within 2" of the top of the knee) No rips or holes.

- No open-toed shoes or hats
- Chapel Day Attire: collared shirts are required, no school t-shirts, no denim pants
- Wear tennis shoes on PE days
- A student may layer with a solid navy, white or khaki sweatshirt or sweater.
- Absolutely no writing, designs, characters or large brand logos (except an RBA logo) on shirts
